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THE FOURTH TRANSNATIONAL MEETING IN ROME



On 26 September, we met in Rome for the fourth transnational meeting of the SAVE Project. The project partners met again to discuss the results of the experimentation of the training modules and the analysis of the results of the experimentation. These results, together with the national evaluations, will feed into the final project manual. The final manual, which will contain contributions from all partners regarding the national contexts, will be prepared and available in all partner languages in November 2022.

THE MULTIPLIER EVENT



In the afternoon, the multiplier event organized by Cemea del Mezzogiorno and Solco took place at CSV Lazio and we had the opportunity to discuss the topic of global citizenship with teachers and students.

We presented the SAVE project, methodology and training tools designed to develop this theme in educational contexts. About 50 people attended the event and there was a very fruitful exchange between associations and organisations involved in voluntary work and especially in teaching language courses for foreigners. In the evening, all partners had a convivial time and visited the city centre.

In July and August, the partners worked on processing the data from the tests of the training modules and creating guidelines for the report that will be part of the IO3. The report will be a useful tool for in-depth analysis and comparison on the topic of global citizenship and, above all, for innovation regarding formal and informal methods of education on global citizenship issues.
